#### FEDERAL UPDATE

- Los Angeles is receiving \$50M from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. \$31M – for Community Development Block Grants to fund eviction defense, expanding domestic violence shelters and services, training and business assistance for workers who have lost their jobs, and assistance for small businesses, and more. \$16 million will go to emergency solutions grants for temporary shelters, transitional housing, and services for our homeless community.

#### STATE UPDATE

- Governor recently signed a new executive order to provide expanded access to child care for essential workers during the COVID-19 response. Read full order [here](#).
- The CA State Association of Counties and the CA Association of County Treasurers and Tax Collectors recently announced that they will use all existing authority to cancel penalties and other charges for homeowners, small businesses, and other property owners that are unable to pay their property taxes due to circumstances caused by COVID-19 on a case-by-case basis. #### CITY/COUNTY UPDATES

- Rents in rent stabilized units in Los Angeles will not go up during this COVID-19 emergency.
- Mayor announced a historic partnership between the Board of Public Works and the Metropolitan YMCA of Los Angeles. 9 YMCA's across the city will be opening up their facilities to allow homeless individuals to use the showers and restrooms.

- An update on the Angeleno Campaign which is providing direct financial assistance to individuals and families facing extreme economic hardship as a result of COVID-19:
  - 2,000 people are receiving \$500,000 in assistance.
  - \$1.2M in grocery gift cards are going out this week

- This fund will also provide \$1,500 cash grants to families who are not eligible to receive the federal cash grants.
- Rec Center Update – as of 4/3/20, there were about 700 beds at rec centers across the city to temporarily shelter homeless individuals. More rec centers are slated to be opened, but the timeline on that has not been confirmed.
