### COVID-19 in Los Angeles County\*



05/04 Update

#### FEDERAL UPDATE:

- Efforts underway to develop a vaccine for COVID-19. There is not yet an FDA approved vaccine for the novel coronavirus. White House is bringing together pharmaceutical companies, government agencies and the military to develop a vaccine as quickly as possible.

#### STATE UPDATE:

- Today, Governor Newsom announced that as early as the end of this week, he would be announcing modifications to the stay at home order, such as allowing certain retail businesses to be allowed to open for curbside pickup only. More information will be available at his Thursday briefing.

#### COUNTY UPDATE:

- Last week, the County Board of Supervisors adopted a motion by Supervisors Barger and Solis calling for a plan detailing measures needed to contain COVID-19 and outlining the prerequisites for relaxing the Safer at Home Public Health Order.

#### CITY UPDATES:

- **LAUSD:** Superintendent Austin Beutner announced that LAUSD will offer summer classes — all online — to any student who wishes to participate. He also shared that the district has not made any decisions about this fall semester and whether students will return to classrooms, continue with distance learning, or both.
